Know Before you Go.

Beds -

The Master bedroom has one queen bed and a private bath plus a window air conditioner. The second bedroom has a double bed (these are both on the main level). In the loft there are 2 Twin extra long beds. There is a ceiling fan in the loft which helps a lot, however, on very warm days the loft can be a bit uncomfortable. The lower level is very cool with a double futon (extra thick mattress that is very comfortable plus the tv. There is also a full bath in the lower level and a great view of the river. If you let us know ahead of time, we will have the futon made into a bed.

Beach access -

You do have your own private river front and the river is perfect for swimming. However, the shore is rocky so swimming shoes are recommended.

Restaurants -

Locally, we only have one restaurant, Summer Place, a couple of blocks up Main Street. They do NOT accept credit cards, cash or checks only. Good local, home cooked meals. Hours vary so you will want to check their schedule for the week. Ishpeming is 24 miles away and there are many restaurants – both chain and local.

Grocery Shopping -

You might want to check out Maki's Market right across the street. It doesn't have much, but seems to have what I need at the last minute. There is also a small store in South Republic – 5 miles down M95 (left when you hit the highway). This is also very limited. Koski's Korner is 7 miles down the road (right when you hit the highway). This is a gas/convenience store. The nearest REAL grocery store is Jubilee or Super One in Ishpeming - turn right when you hit the highway, turn right at Koski's Korner and about 20 miles down the road. They also have Snyder's Drug store and several restaurants.

If you would like to order your groceries ahead of time, we have options for you. You can either give me a list, or order online and I will pick up and have all put away for you when you arrive. Email or call to discuss your options.

Supplies -

Extra cleaning supplies, paper towels, toilet paper, etc, can be located in the pantry. Whatever you find in the pantry, feel free to use. Coffee (Keurig), tea, popcorn, ketchup, mustard, salt, pepper, etc. will be available.

Firepit -

There is plenty of wood so feel free to build a fire. Marshmallows, Hershey bars and graham crackers are there for you. Roasting sticks are also available.

Kayaks and Lifejackets -

There are 4 kayaks for you to use. If it works into your schedule, we would be happy to drop you off up the river (various distances) and you can paddle back. The river is usually calm and you would be paddling with the current. Our youngest kayak guest was 7 years old and he did GREAT, but he pretty much just stayed around the area and was closely supervised.

Please be sure you are wearing life jackets. Safety FIRST! We have size child 30-50 lbs, youth 50-90 lbs, Adult Small, (2) Adult Medium, Adult Large life jackets.

Feeding the Birds -

I feed the birds on the deck once per day (anytime). If you do feed them, you will be forever entertained by various beautiful birds. The seed is located in the pantry. The hummingbird feeders are all set up for your stay.

Feeding the chipmunks -

These little critters will eat whatever you give them. SO, I limit their feeding to once per day. Food is located in the pantry. They are very friendly and you almost need to make sure you don't step on them.

Wifi -

Be sure to connect to our wifi. You also might want to connect your phone as phone service in this area can be somewhat limited unless connected to wifi:

TV –

We get a few local channels, but we also have streaming options. Instructions are located with the 55" tv on the lower level, although you might want to spend most of your time outdoors! There are also puzzles, books and magazines available.

Iron Ore Heritage Trail -

This 47-mile trail actually starts about one block from here. Following the trail will actually take you all the way to Marquette. The beginning of the trail is very near the Methodist Church that is visible at the top of the hill. It's a nice little walk as far as you want to go. Although it is listed as a bike trail, you would need a trail bike from here to Ishpeming.

In Republic -

There are a couple of items that might be of interest for you. If you head up the hill and walk right past the campgrounds, you will come to an Open Pit Mine Overview. Although the gate is usually locked, there is an opening to the Observation Deck to the right of the road.

This is a nice little walk. There is also a very nice flower garden area between here and the Methodist Church, up the hill. Nice gazebo to stop and rest. St. Vincent de Paul has a Thrift Store right on Kloman Avenue (main street). They have limited hours but have a lot of interesting merchandise. You can stop at Summer Place for an ice cream cone. The Antique Store is also interesting; however, their hours are limited and always posted on the door.

There is a beach right across the river. Just turn right at the top of the hill and go over the bridge. Follow the road around and you can't

miss it. Nice playground for kids and a very nice sandy beach. Braver souls can swim out to the raft.

The Pine Grove bar often has live music on the weekends.

Garbage -

All garbage must be placed in garbage bags (located under the sink). Once a bag is full, please place it outside in the large blue garbage bin.

Bug Spray -

We do spray the yard for bugs, but recommend that you use bug spray when you are outside, especially on any trails, etc. If you forget to bring yours, we have some available for you.

Emergencies -

The nearest Emergency Room is located in Ishpeming. Once you get into Ishpeming, turn left at the first stop light and follow the signs.


When you leave –




Getting there!


